SimTiki Visiting International Medical Student (VIMS) Program is available for 2-4 weeks. VIMS provides active learning opportunities to practice application of clinical skills in a simulation based program. The program is integrated with the JABSOM MD5 "FACTs" (Fundamental Acute Care Techniques) elective, offering the opportunity to study side by side with JABSOM level 2 medical students. BLS/ACLS certification, clinical observation, preparation of an academic portfolio and a mix of other exciting educational activities are available.
